We do encourage “trunkers” to bring their own candy or prizes as a donation to the organization. However, if you are unable to provide these or run out during the event, Manahan will provide candy for you.

Rules:

- All vehicles are welcome but must fit in the allocated parking space on the path.
- You and your vehicle can arrive as early as 12:00 p.m.
- You and your vehicle must arrive **NO LATER** than 1:00 p.m.
- Please be curious to your trunk neighbors and keep your decorations confined to your parking space.
- Electricity will **NOT** be provided for “trunkers”.
- Amplified music is allowed as long as it has no profanity, vulgar language, and does not impede on other trunks.
- Vehicle owners do **NOT** need to come in costume or decorate their vehicle; however, we highly encourage vehicles to be decorated!
- Vehicles will not be permitted to move or leave the parking lot until the conclusion of the event at 4:30 p.m. unless an emergency arises.
- Trunks and their owners will be photographed at the event.
- An adult must remain with the vehicle the entire time.
- Have fun and be safe!
